

**CITY OF PRESCOTT, WISCONSIN  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2021 ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Ordinance Committee was held Monday September 13, 2021 at the Municipal Building, 800 Borner St. Prescott, WI 54021

Aldersperson Hintz called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members present were Dar Hintz, Bailey Ruona and Thomas Oss. City Administrator Matt Wolf and City Clerk Jayne Brand represented staff.

**Otwell/Hintz motion to approve the minutes for July 12, 2021 passed without a negative voice vote.**

The committee discussed Ordinance 235-6 “Animals restricted on public grounds and cemeteries”. It was discussed to remove under the immediate and direct control of the owner or his/her designed representative from the ordinance and leave dogs on a leash not to exceed 15 feet in length. **Oss/Ruona motion to recommend removal of under the immediate and direct control of the owner or his/her designed representative from the ordinance and leave dogs on a leash not to exceed 15 feet in length passed without a negative voice vote.**

Discussion was held on the turn around on Lake Street to not allowing swimming in this area. The area can be used walking dogs on a leash, kayak, non-motorized boats and radio control boats. It was also recommended that no loitering signs be also put up in this area. Resident Brandon Wilde questioned the parking. People are also parking on the grass. It was suggested no parking signs go up in the grassy areas. City staff will work on a resolution designating uses for this area.

Quota for intoxicating and fermented malt beverages was discussed. A quota was established in January 2012 for the Class “A” licenses and the city has issued this quota. None of the alderpersons were in favor of changing these quotas. **Ruona/Oss motion to retain the quota for Class “A” intoxicating and fermented malt beverages passed without a negative voice vote.**

City Administrator Matt Wolf proposed a change to the Highway Commercial District (C-2) to make manufactured and mobile home, vehicle and equipment sales and service establishments a conditional use and remove warehousing, wholesaling and storage establishment from this zoning code. Warehousing, wholesaling and storage establishments are usually found in industrial zoning districts. **Ruona/Hintz motion to recommend staff move forward with the proposed changes as discussed passed without a negative voice.**

Other Business:

Need an ordinance for prohibiting fire arms in public buildings and property.

City Administrator Matt Wolf asked about establishing an ordinance so driveways would be concrete or blacktopped. The committee was not in favor of an ordinance at this time,

**Ruona/Oss motion to adjourn passed without a negative voice vote.**
