

**CITY OF PRESCOTT, WISCONSIN  
POLICE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 24, 2018**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Police Commission was held on Wednesday, October 24, 2018, 800 Borner St., Prescott, WI 54021.

Call to order/Roll Call: President Bill Prior called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Members present were Bill Prior, Neil Riley, Bill Fetzner, Mark Pierce and Cheri Johnson.

Sean Riley was present and asked the Commission about his concern on changing policies and an issue he had with two officers. President Bill Prior explained to Riley that the Commission only does hiring, firing and discipline. It was then explained to Riley the correct process he would need to go through with the Police Department.

**Pierce/Riley motioned to go into closed Session Wisconsin Stats. 19.85 (1) (f) Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations – Complaint against an Officer Wisconsin Stats. 19.85 (1) (c) - Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – Application for Chief of Police position. Passed unanimously via roll call vote.**

**Johnson/Riley motioned to go into open session. Passed unanimously.**

**Prior/Riley motioned to have Chief Interviews on December 1, at 9:00am. Passed without a negative vote.**

**Fetzner/Riley motioned to adjourn and passed without a negative vote.**
