JUNE 28, 2021 PARKS AND PUBLIC PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Parks and Public Property Committee was held, Monday, June 28, 2021, Municipal Building, 800 Borner Street, Prescott, WI 54021.

Call to Order: Alderperson Ruona called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. Members present were Rob Daugherty. Pat Knox was excused. City Administrator Jayne Brand represented staff.

Daugherty/Ruona motion to approve the minutes for May 24, 2021 passed without a negative voice vote.

The committee reviewed the master parks plan. The Lake Street Canoe & Kayak Launch were discussed. The committee would like to see the master parks plan changed to manually operated boat launch. Removal of the parking area expansion. On site look at garbage can. Come up with standardized signage to include

- Dogs on a leash
- Clean up after your dog
- No alcohol
- No swimming
- No littering
- Park open sunrise to sunset

It was discussed to look at a fishing dock and also grants for the steps and retaining wall.

The committee also reviewed the Magee Wilderness Park. They would like to add mountain bike trails to the amenities inventory. Under recommendations remove new park shelter, solar park lighting and dog park.

It was suggested the trails which are being worked on by the Friends of Freedom Park should be added to the sidewalk and trails plan.

The committee would like to do a parks tour.
