Minutes from September 10, 2018 was approved unanimously via roll call vote.

Johnson/Riley motion to go into closed Session Wisconsin Stats. 19.85 (1) (f) Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations – Complaint against an Officer & 19.85 (1) (c) - Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – Application for Part-time/Full-time Officers and Chief of Police position. Passed unanimously via roll call vote.

Prior/Pierce motioned to go into open session passed without a negative vote.

It was decided to move forward with Part-time & Full-time Officer applications. Chief applications were also discussed.
